Study for Passage Key and adjacent beaches.

### Anna Maria Island Beach - Hurricane Hermine - \$2,012,849 (Project #6003412)

Anna Maria Island Hurricane Hermine restoration.

### Beach: Longboat Pass Impl (Jetty) Study 17ME3- \$173,385 (Project #6003413)

Design, permitting, construction.

### Beach FEMA Hurricane Damage Anna Maria - IRMA - \$2,018,938 (Project #6003415)

Preparation of bid documents, agency coordination and construction.

### Central Beach Nourishment 2019 - \$7,631,859 (Project #6003416)

Construction, permit will require environmental, physical and biological monitoring for three years.

### Coquina Beach Add'l Sand Replacement - \$7,055,101 (Project #6003417)

Seeking to obtain permits for the Coquina Beach Renourishment Project and mitigative reef.

### Coquina Beach Stabilization Structures - \$2,794,500 (Project #6083418)

Feasibility study, planning, design, permitting, construction phase services, and construction.

### Longboat Pass Jetty Rehabilitation - \$1,600,000 (Project #6003419)

Feasibility, design, permitting and construction

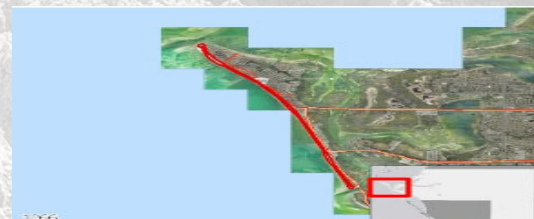
### Mitigation Reef - \$101,500 (Project #NR01805)
